A crisp, orange-red ale brewed with additions of rye for a dry finish with citrus US hop notes

Bad Egg 4.1% (Spring/Easter)

Brown to ruby in colour with a full-bodied malty taste and Goldings hop aroma

Good Egg 4.1% (Spring/Easter)

Balanced dark golden ale, with English & New Zealand hop varieties. Dry hopped giving a fresh aroma & aftertaste

Jubilee Mild 4.5% (May)

A dark and malty easy drinking mild

Reedham Gold 3.6% (Summer)

Very pale & hoppy session ale with US Cascade & Summit hops

Citrus Sunshine 4.1% (Summer)

Dark golden ale brewed with heaps of different American citrussy hops also with a fruity nose. Sunshine in a glass!

Hop Harvest Gold 4.5% (Autumn)

A pale golden ale brewed with a variety of hops, including freshly harvested 2019 Goldings hops from Kitchenham Farm, Bodiam East Sussex to celebrate the season

Christmas Crackling 4.5% (December/Christmas)

A full bodied amber ale, brewed with Cascade and First Gold hop varieties to give an aromatic and hoppy winter ale

Christmas Crack 7.0% (December/Christmas)

A strong dark brown ale with an American hop profile – a cracker of a beer!

Nord Atlantic 3.7%

A mid brown, thirst quenching hoppy ale with Target & Centennial hops – a fine session beer

Branch Line Bitter 3.9%

A light, chestnut bitter brewed with a complex mix of malts for a rich body and English hops for a spicy & fruity aroma

Lemon & Ginger 4.0%

A crisp pale amber ale, finished with a refreshing lemon & ginger tang 2012 Norwich & Norfolk CAMRA SIlver Medal, Speciality Beer

Swingbridge Stout 4.1%

A robust black stout with a fine balance of roasty and hoppy notes and a pale brown rich creamy head

Black Forest Stout 4.1%

A dark roasty stout, brewed with cacao nibs and fresh cherries for a taste of the Black Forest

new Humpty Dumpty Ale 4.2%

An amber ale with a malty backbone & spicy, resinous hoppy notes, plus a fruity nose & aftertaste

Red Mill 4.3%

A crisp hoppy red ale with caramel & fruit notes

Reedcutter 4.4%

A premium golden ale with English & US hop varieties giving a spicy bitterness & a fruity citrus finish

The King John 4.5%

A full bodied golden amber ale with a late finish of First Gold hops Third Place, 2012 Norfolk Real Ale in a Bottle Competition

Cheltenham Flyer 4.6%

A clean, crisp amber ale with a hint of malt at the start soon overtaken by a refreshing dry hop bitterness

Norfolk Nectar 4.6%

An amber ale infused with local honey; refreshing hop bitterness lingers on the palate to leave a slight honey & vanilla sweetness

East Anglian Pale Ale 4.6%

Amber best bitter with a dry hop addition of Comet hops for a citrussy hop bouquet
Third Place, 2012 Norfolk Real Ale in a Bottle Competition
Gold Medal, 2009 Norfolk Bottled Ale Championship – "an ale full of quintessential IPA hoppiness"

Big Sharpie 5.0%

Brewed every 100th brew! A strong pale ale brewed with Magnum, Cascade and Citra hops, then dry-hopped with more Cascade and Citra for a big citrus hop finish. Little Sharpies big brother!

Black Mill 5.0%

A heavily hopped Cascadian style black ale, brewed with 6 different hop varieties

Railway Sleeper 5.0%

A full bodied strong ale with a reddish brown hue, in which the nose is predominantly fruity; a good malty mouthfeel then proceeds to leave a long lasting dry finish

Porter 5.4%

A traditional London style porter which used chocolate & black malts in the recipe; a good full roast aroma with hints of liquorice on the tongue and a dry bitter finish

Golden Gorse 5.4%

A finely balanced premium pale golden ale with a fruity sweetness on the nose which is quickly overtaken by a rush of Cascade hops leaving a pleasant bitter aftertaste

"21" Anniversary Barleywine 9.0%

A rich, smooth ruby red barleywine hopped with US and UK hop varieties
